

COSI PRESCHOOL OUTREACH FAQS

What age level is COSI Preschool Outreach geared toward? Preschool Outreach is designed to accommodate preschool students, ages 3-5 years old.

Can we schedule more than one session during the school day? Yes. Preschool Outreach can offer up to four sessions in a school day.

Can we schedule a program with more than 20 students? The program is designed to provide high levels of student interaction and engagement. To achieve this goal each program accommodates a maximum of 20 students.

Why do we need extra adult volunteers?

Each program consists of a group demonstration conducted by the Outreach Educator as well as four hands-on activity centers. We will need two to three volunteers available per session. These can be the teachers, teacher's aides, or parents. Volunteers should actively engage with children during activities. They can also assist the COSI Educator as needed. In addition, there needs to be one volunteer to assist the COSI Educator with set-up and tear down. This volunteer can be one of the two volunteers that help during the session but does not have to be.

Is COSI Preschool Outreach accessible to students with physical or mental disabilities?

All COSI Preschool Outreach Programs are accessible to students with disabilities.
