



The Travel Passport Program entitles visitors to free **general** admission. It does not include free admission to special exhibits, planetarium and larger-screen theater presentations nor does it include museum store discounts and other benefits associated with museum membership unless stated otherwise. Acquaint yourself with the family admittance policies (denoted by "F:") of Passport Program sites before visiting. PROGRAM RESTRICTIONS

- Based on participants' location:** Science Centers/Museums located within a 90-mile (150- km) radius of each other are excluded from the Passport Program unless that exclusion is lifted by mutual agreement. 90 miles must be measured "as the crow flies" and not by driving distance. Museums may create their own local reciprocal free-admission program. ASTC does not require or participate in these agreements, or dictate their terms.
- Based on members' residence:** Passport Program benefits do not apply to those members whose principal place of residence is within a participating science center's or museum's local market area. In other words, to receive Passport Program benefits, your members must live more than 90 miles away from the center/museum they wish to visit. Passport Program venues may choose to enforce this rule or not. Those opting-in must notify ASTC during the appropriate "updating" period, and implement the rule effective May 1 or November 1. Sites that check IDs will be marked on the Passport list as **(VIDs)** so visitors know what to expect.
