Science Wonders "Static Electricity"	Learn about static electricity in its many forms. Make your hair stand on end!	Electrostatic Generator – Level One (Atrium)
Careers "Future Jobs"	Interview some COSI Team Members and ask them what they wanted to grow up to be when they were young. Think about how the world would be when you are older.	Progress - Level Two North
Through the Years "Sing a Song" "Language of the Times"	Learn about an earlier decade (like the 1890s or 1960s). Can you learn a popular song from that period? What about popular words or phrases?	Progress - Level Two North
Dancercise "My Own Dance"	Make up a dance to your favorite song or choose a song from the book and create a dance.	Dancemania
Dancercise "Dance Party"	Have a dance party with a group of friends.	Dancemania
Listening to the Past "Community Stories"	Get to know the stories of some of the oldest people in your community.	Progress - Level Two North
Earth is Our Home "Project Recycle"	Learn about recycling. Get a list of items that can be recycled.	Trashformations, Level One North
Science in Action "Science and Technology Hunt"	Find examples of science and technology (from the list in the Brownie Try It Book).	Explore COSI
Space Explorer "Ready, Set, Jet!"	Learn what an astronaut does to prepare for a journey into space, including what they would eat and how they might dress.	Freedom Space Station – Space, Level One
Animals "Looks Mean Something"	Explore the animals at COSI. Which ones have more than 4 legs...no legs...scales...fur?	Rat Basketball – Level Two
My Body "Pulse"	Take your pulse by placing three fingers of the hand you write with on the flat side of your neck.	Heartbeat Drum – Atrium
